- Athletic Director's Report, Pat DeCamillis
 - Spring sports are doing well and coaches are doing awesome
 - Track is deep in boys and hold several of the tops positions in the state; girls have qualified in several events and will have to choose which events to participate in
 - Girls Soccer is 2-2, with a last great win over Niwot
 - Tennis is showing a lot of progress
 - Baseball beat the top two teams in the state recently
 - Girls Golf played in a tournament that day and hit well
 - CHSAA has approved new conference leagues beginning in Fall 24. SCHS will be in the Granite Peaks League with 13 other schools: Broomfield, Centaurus, Erie, Fairview, Frederick, Holy Family, Horizon, Legacy, Longmont, Mead, Monarch, Niwot and Skyline. Football, wrestling and swimming are not impacted by this new conference.
 - Homecoming is September 16-21st with the home football game on Friday, Sept 20 and dance on the 21st.
 - Fall sports (tryouts) begin August 12, per CHSAA
 - Open coaching positions: conducting Softball interview this week, no Volleyball applicants.
