General Updates

Principal's Report Finnestead / Norris

- SCHS has 4 National Merit Scholars
- Success at State for the Debate team.
- Turf and track upgrades are set to begin now with a delivery date of Aug 1, so SCHS will host home soccer games and potentially football game(s) in the fall.
- New LED sign on Nelson will be installed in June/July
- VEX robotics will return to SCHS with a contribution from SCEF of \$9k to help build/acquire the arena and equipment and will have four teams.
- French National Honor Society (an internationally recognized society) has been established, and the first students inducted
- SHCS is experiencing a slight population decline and will have 1210 students next year, down from 1245. Will not lose programming but may not replace a retiring teacher
- Graduation class size is 302-315
- Spring Musical James and the Giant Peach will be May 4-5
- Band and fiddle groups are visiting feeder schools and elementary schools to get students excited
- A coach bus for prom has been secured, and a form was sent out to students
- Raptor Tech is hosting a signing day for 2027 grads. Want to recruit 3-4 more. Students will graduate with a AA degree through participation in the program

Athletic Director's Report Pat DeCamillis

- Winter sports have concluded
 - Girls Swim and Dive had 2 all-conference swimmers and 4 divers. Finished in the top 10 at State meet
 - Girls basketball finished 7-16. A couple of very close games, and the girls fought hard
 - Boys basketball finished 16-9. Lost in the playoffs to the eventual state champs
 - Wrestling was 7-6 and 1 state qualifier
 - Unified won versus the police
- Coaching updates: new Volleyball coach and dance coach have been hired.
- Senior Night and Athletic Awards night will be on different nights this year.
